



ITINERARY

Day 01. Arrival

Baggage collection and customs, Meet & Greet after transfer to the pre-booked hotel.

Assistance for completing hotel check-in formalities.

Overnight stay in Delhi Hotel.

Day 02. Delhi Sightseeing

Breakfast at hotel, proceed for visit of Old Delhi: Old Delhi: An ancient walled city.

Visit to Rajghat is a memorial in Delhi where Mahatma Gandhi, was cremated following his assassination in the year 1948. Then drive past Red Fort (photo - stop), the most opulent Fort and Palace of the Mughal Empire

"Cycle rickshaw ride in the narrow by lanes of Old Delhi visiting Chawri Bazar & Dariba Kalan (silver market) - is incomplete without seeing the actual life of the people to meet their daily expenses.

Jama Masjid - is the largest mosque in India and stands across the road from the Red Fort, built in 1656 by Shahjahan.

Then drive towards Parliament House and President House and Gurudwara Bangla Sahib is one of the most revered places of



worship in Delhi, Visit India Gate, a war memorial commemorating martyrs of the British-Indian army.

Visit Humayun's Tomb and Qutab Minar 72 meters high and one of the most perfect towers in the Persian world. The Iron Pillar which has survived the vagaries of weather for over 1500 years.

Lotus Temple - known as 'Bahai House of Worship' (Monday Closed), this 20th century wonder made of marble in the form of a white half-opened lotus flower.

Overnight stay in Delhi Hotel.

Day 03. Delhi – Jaipur

Drive to Jaipur Hotel. Jaipur is the capital of India's Rajasthan state; it evokes the royal family that once ruled the region and that, in 1727, now called the Old City or the 'Pink City' Jaipur is the land of royalty and vivid culture. Admire the class of Rajput architecture and colorful Rajasthani culture. On reaching Jaipur, check-in, Relax, Vehicle at disposal

Overnight stay in Jaipur Hotel. (Approx. 265kms-05hrs)

Day 04. Jaipur Sightseeing

Post breakfast, day is scheduled for Jaipur City tour.

Tour Start with Excursion to Amber Fort is an architectural wonder, also counted as the most excellent example of the Indo-Islamic architecture.



Enjoy an Elephant Ride to the Amber Fort (climb up the Fort on Elephant's back like the Maharajas).

Followed by photo stop Jaimahal amidst the center of the lake is adorned with the exquisite mirror work and abstract inlay design and Hawa Mahal or the Palace of winds through the rose - pink structures, the official building.


Next visit is to the Jaipur City Palace, a palace with amazing cultural value and architectural excellence, which contains the original collection of the Maharajas of Jaipur housing paintings, royal dresses and typical Rajasthani handicraft

Then walk towards Jantar Mantar. Also known as the Royal Observatory, the Jantar Mantar has a collection of astronomical instruments that are meticulously designed to measure the harmony of the heavens.

Then head towards Nawab Saheb ki Haveli, a famous house in the Bapu Bazar area. Explore Bapu Bazar, a famous market in Jaipur and other local markets to enjoy shopping. Buy authentic and traditional Jewellery, clothes and precious gemstone from Johari Bazaar. Buy wooden souvenirs and colourful handicrafts from Mirza Ismail Road. Overnight stay in Jaipur Hotel

Day 05. Jaipur – Fatehpur Sikri – Agra

Leisurely Breakfast at Hotel, Check-out after you will start your journey from Jaipur to Agra by road.



On the way, halt at Fatehpur Sikri - Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, a the abandoned, Red Sandstone City built in the 16th century by the Mughal Emperor Akbar, the architecture of Fatehpur Sikri is a combination of Hindu and Muslim styles. The attractions you will cover here include Jodha Bai Palace: reflects a blended architectural style of the Hindu and the Mughal, Tomb of Salim Chishti and Jama Masjid, Jodha Bai Palace is a neighbor to another house called Birbal Bhawan, Panch Mahal, and the Buland Darwaza: an iconic structure is Buland Darwaza built by the emperor Akbar as a sign of victory over Gujarat in 1601. Each site endures the great creativity and historical significance of the Mughal Dynasty, Panch Mahal, a five-storied structure open on all sides and built from red sandstone. Continue drive, on reaching Agra, Check-in at hotel Overnight stay in Agra Hotel. (Approx. 245kms-05hrs)

Day 06. Agra Sightseeing & Drive to Delhi

Post breakfast, day is scheduled for Agra City tour and then you will start your journey from Agra to Delhi by road.

Taj Mahal: is considered one of the most romantic monuments in the world. Built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan after the death of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, this white marble mausoleum is considered a monument to eternal love. [Note: Taj Mahal is closed on Fridays for general viewing and is opened on Friday afternoon only for those who have to attend prayers at the Taj Mosque and there is



no limit to how long tourists may stay inside the monument complex within the normal operating hours].

Agra Fort Built between 1565 and 1571 AD, Inside

Arrive Delhi, check-in at hotel

Evening visit Delhi Swaminarayan Akshardham is a Hindu temple, and spiritual-cultural campus in Delhi, Also referred to as Akshardham Temple or Akshardham Delhi, the complex displays millennia of traditional and modern Hindu culture, spirituality, and architecture.

Enjoy Water Show/First show starts soon after sunset.

Multiple shows may be held during weekends or public holidays

(Currently 7:15 pm - Time to see: 24 minutes)

Returned to hotel, Overnight stay in Delhi Hotel. (Approx. 235kms-04hrs)


Day 07. Departure

Breakfast at Hotel, Check-out,


On time transfer to Airport to board your international flight.

At the airport, the driver will assist you with the luggage and will later drop you at the terminal.


